




ASSEMBLY PRECAUTIONS

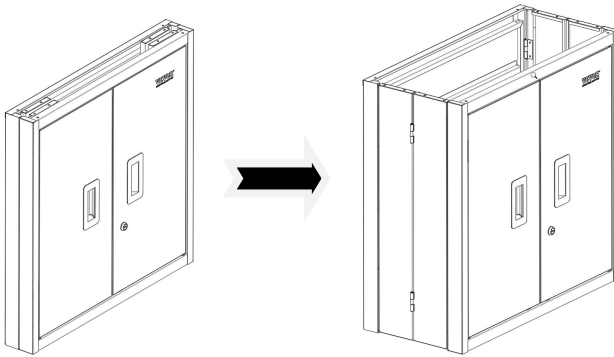

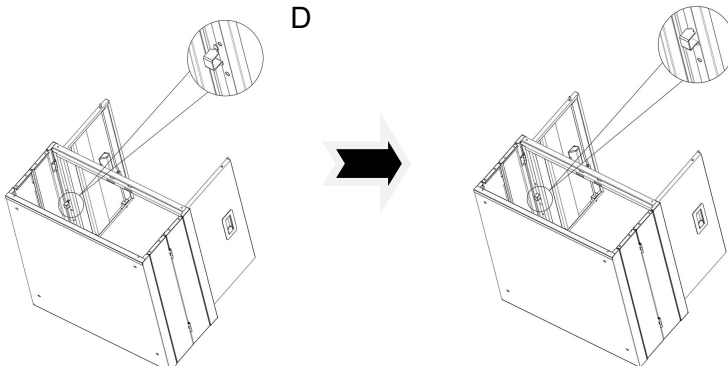

ASSEMBLY STEP

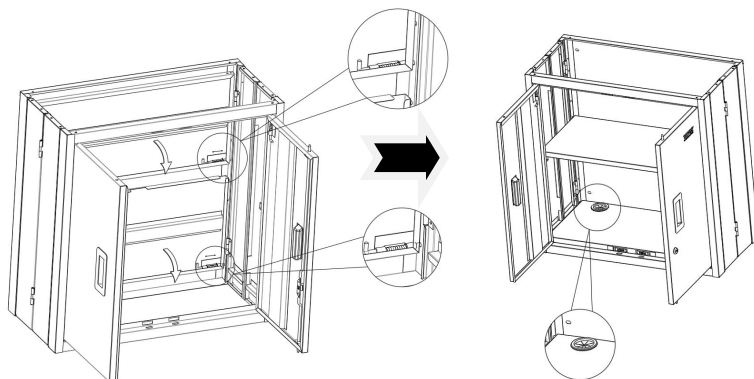
1. Take the product out of the packaging and open it.



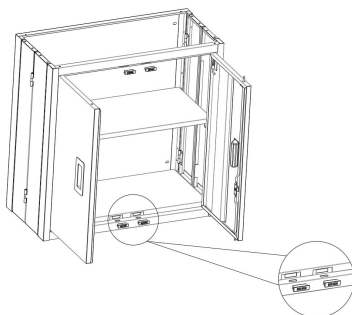
2. Install the shelf support. Please note that there are 4 adjustable installation slots upon opening for adjusting the height of the middle shelf. However, it can only be folded when installed in the second hole from the top.



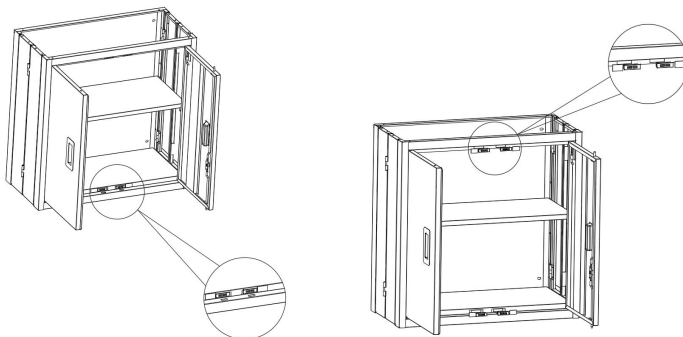
3. Open the middle shelf and bottom shelf as shown in the following picture. The overcoil(Part E) was installed before leaving the factory, and there is no need for you to install it.



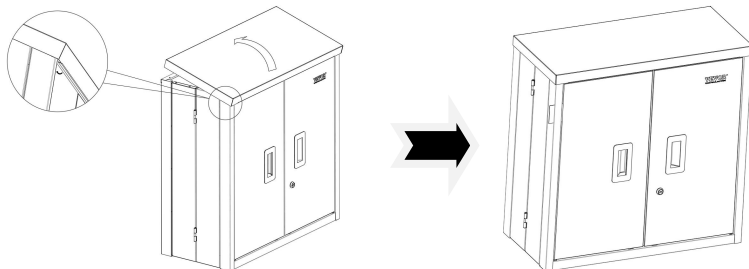
4. Install the magnet (part C)



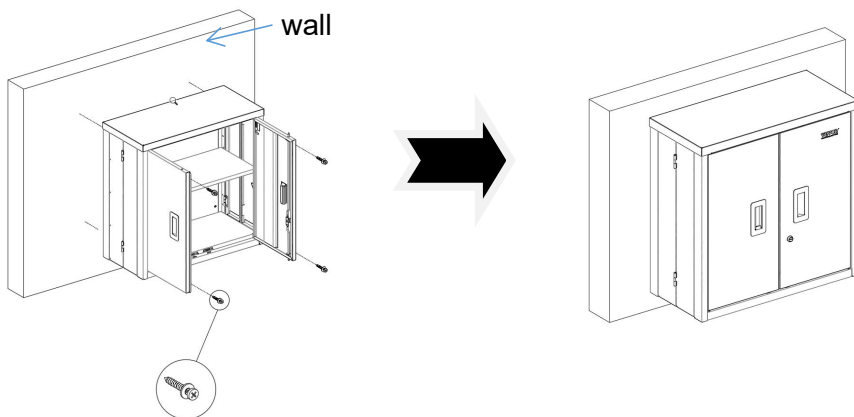
5. Install EVA(part J) stickers next to the magnet. The EVA of the upper and lower ends of the door frame are attached to the magnet, as shown in the figure.



6. Install the top shelf(part B). Please note that the top shelf should be hooked onto the side of the cabinet door first before being covered.



7. Install the garage wall cabinet onto the wall. Please note that the holes should be drilled accurately. The rubber plug (part G) should be securely inserted into the wall to ensure stability, and the screws must be tightened with a washer. They need to be fully tightened. Before installation, please make sure that the wall surface is flat.



8. Please ensure that the weight is evenly distributed and do not exceed the weight limit when in use.

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
