INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Please dispose of all plastic bags carefully and keep them away from children and pet.
2. Check all components provided according to the list in this manual. Make sure you have all of the parts listed.
3. Although paying particular attention when manufacturing this product, you must be careful during the assembly process to avoid being scratched by sharp edges.
4. Wear protective gloves, during assembly and using.

ASSEMBLY STEPS

HOW TO SET UP A NINJA OBSTACLE COURSE?

Step 1:Where to Slack line?

Picking a place to slack line is mostly based on personal preference. To set up the ninja line,two objects will be needed to tie it into place(typically trees).

Installation height: the starting position is recommended to be greater than 7.2 feet End position:lower than the starting position,the greater the difference from the starting position,the faster the sliding speed.

Step 2:Attach the main line to a tree or solid post.



Step 3:Attach the ratchet line to another tree or solid post.

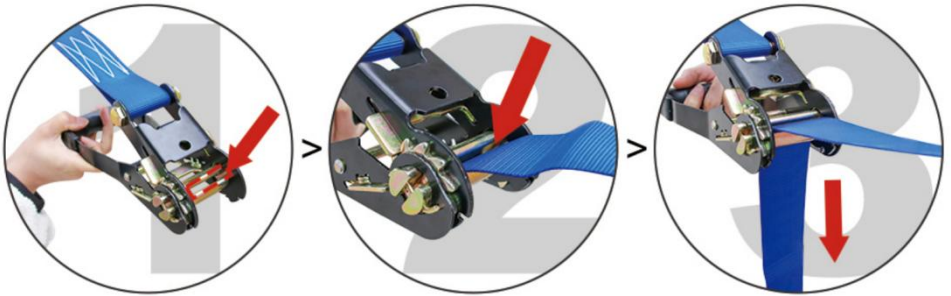
Step 4:Protecting the trees.If trees are not being used as anchoring objects,this step can be omitted.

Step 5:How to use the slack line ratchet?

In order to properly use your ratchet straps,thread the strap through the mandrel and then crank the ratchet to tighten it. To release the strap,press the release tab and open the ratchet.

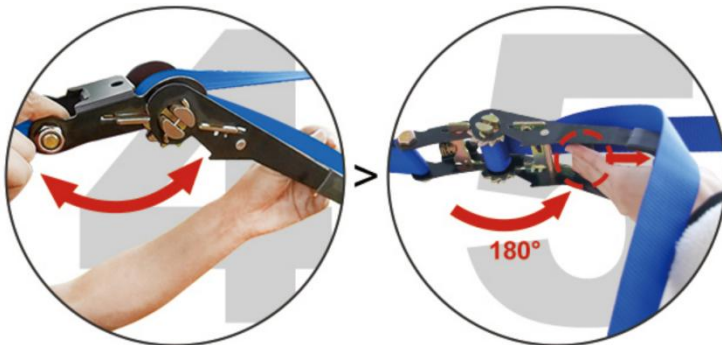
Step 6: Hang the swing onto the pulley with a safety buckle.When you finish installing the slack line,it is recommended that you have them tested. Take care to reduce the probabilities of injury.We sincerely hope you enjoy your ninja line kit as much as possible.Have fun!

HOW TO USE RATCHET?



1. First, close the ratchet, and thread the webbing go through the upper hole in the middle of the ratchet. If the position of the hole is not above, it can be adjusted to the top by opening and closing the ratchet.

2. Pull the webbing down until it is as tight as possible. Then tighten the webbing with one hand and hold the handle of the ratchet with the other hand. Tighten the webbing by continuously opening and closing the ratchet. Until you can't pull the handle of the ratchet. Note: please make sure your ratchet is closed when it is finally tight-end.



3. When you are ready to stow the slack line kit, you can pull the switch marked in the figure outward and open the handle of the ratchet to about 180° at the same time. After hearing the "bang", you can pull the webbing out of the ratchet and put it away

USE METHOD OF PULLEY

- 1.Thread the pulley onto the main line before installing the slackline,then tighten the ratchet by following the steps above.
- 2.Open the safety buckle and hook the swing to it.
- 3.Then hang the safety buckle onto the hook of the pulley and tighten the locking cap.



Note:the use of pulley combination is dangerous.please take protective measures for your child before use and use it under the supervision of adults.

CLEANING AND STORAGE

1. Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. Never use an abrasive cleanser or harsh pad. Do not clean with water or other liquids. Be sure to keep the product dry
2. Children are **not allowed** to wipe the product to avoid tipping and falling injuries.
3. After the product is disassembled, please put the parts and accessories together.

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
