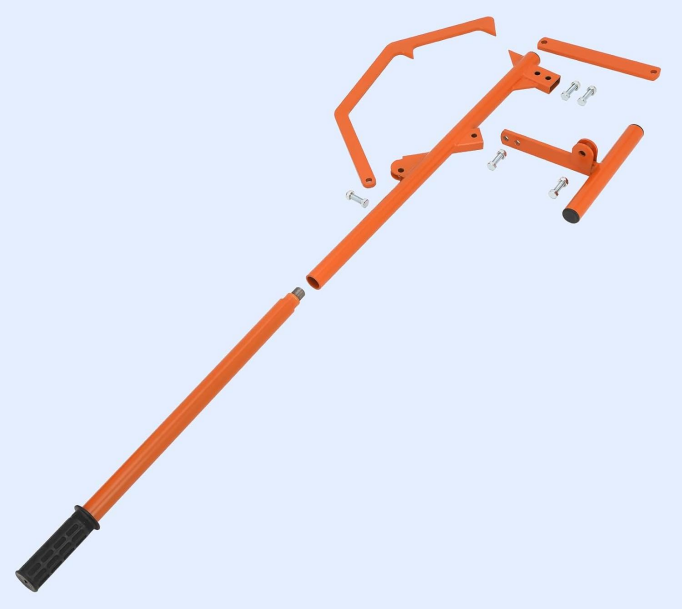
Before using the log Jack, be sure all bolts are fastened and tightened.

Maintenance

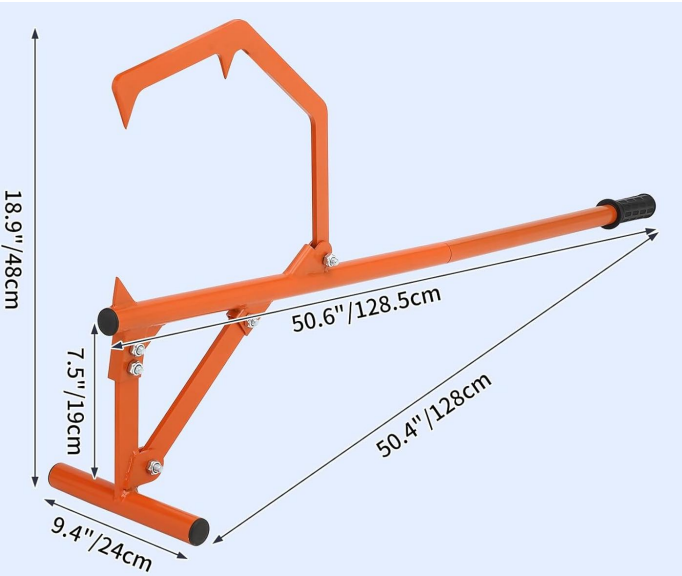

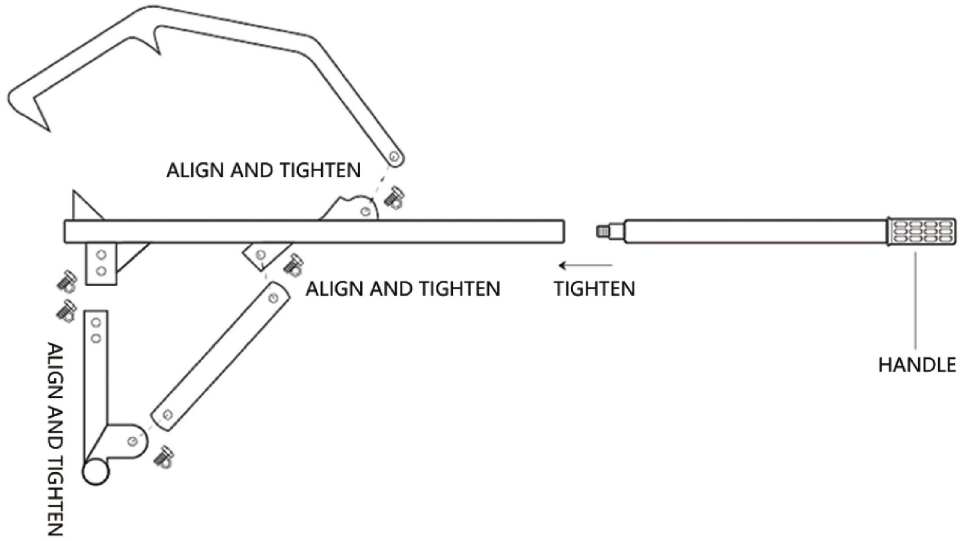
