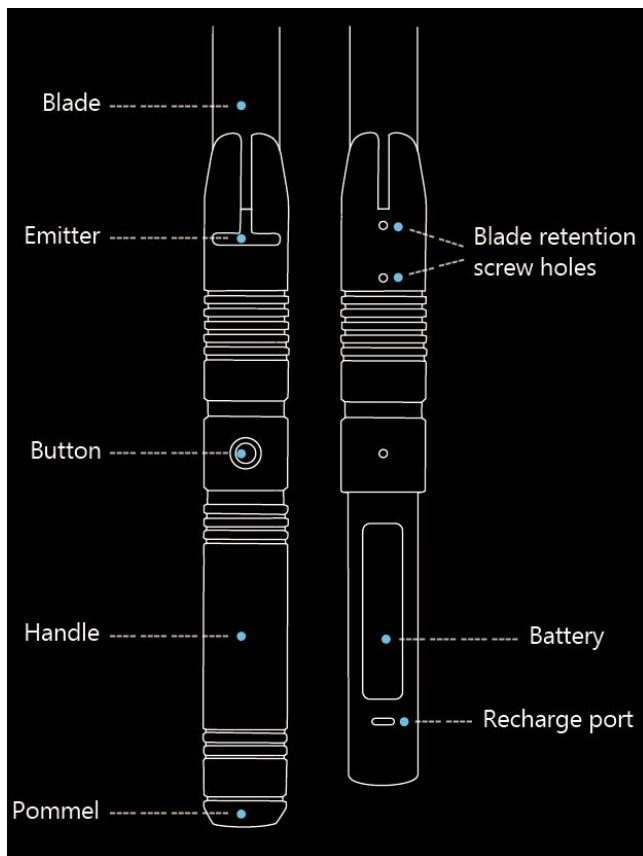

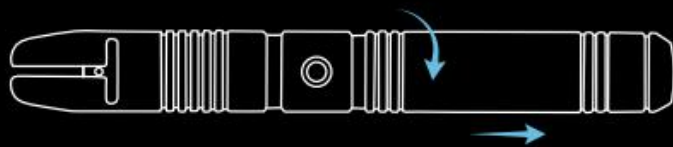

## ► ILLUSTRATION OF MODEL

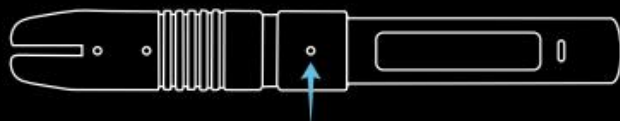


## ► DISMANTLING

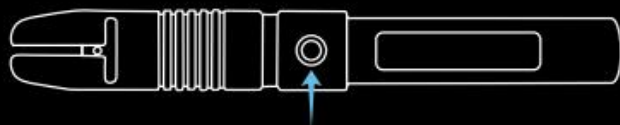
① Rotate and unscrew the lightsaber body



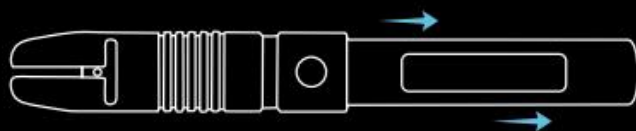
② Unscrew the back screws of the handle



③ Push the switch button from the handle surface into the infrastructure

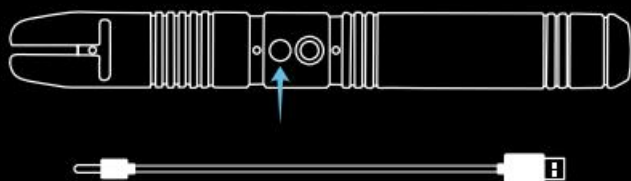


④ Pull down the inner structure

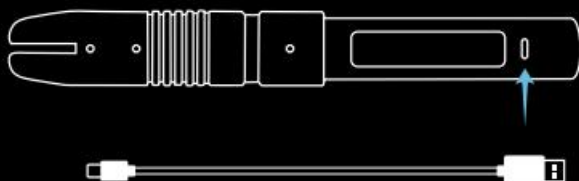


## ► CHARGING DIAGRAM

- ① For models with an external charging port, please use the charging cable provided by the merchant to plug in and charge.



- ② For models with built-in charging port, please unscrew the saber pommel or handle, and then use the charging cable provided by the merchant to plug in and charge.



- ③ For models without a charging port, please unscrew the saber handle, then take out the battery and use the charging box provided by the merchant to charge.



## ► USE

Assemble: Use threads to assemble the hilt and body of the Laser sword as shown in Figure 1

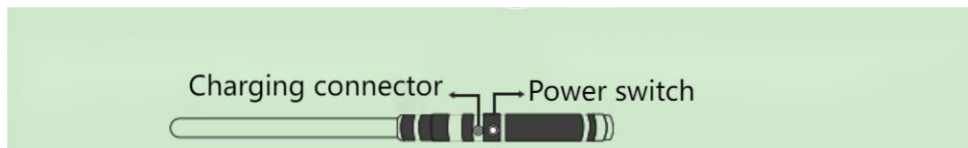


The connector can connect two laser swords into one, as shown in Figure 2 and Figure 3, it is an purchase if you need.



### Charging light

The recommended charging time is 3-4 hours (please follow the charging light, the light will go out when the charging is completed.)



On/ Off: Press the switch button to start, and press the switch to switch the light mode(long press the switch for 3 seconds to shut down).

Mode: Click the switch to switch the light mode. The sound of the sword is heard when hitting, and the sound of the Force lightsaber current is heard in the background, double click to enter the flash

mode, three hits to enter the silent mode, repeat three hits to restore the background sound.

► **FAQ**

① The saber has no sound

Please confirm whether it is in mute mode, and you can adjust volume mode or reinstall the battery.

② The blade is easy to loosen

Make sure that the screws that secure the blade are tightened. In addition, it is normal for the screws and the blade to loosen during the fight. You can change the fixed position of the screw and tighten the screw.

③ Saber cannot be turned on

Please charge the saber first to make sure it is fully charged. If it still can't be solved, please remove the battery and reinstall it (pay attention to the positive and negative poles), and make sure the battery is in contact with it.
