INTENDED USE

The product is intended for the rolling of soil and turf in or around the home domestic garden. It may only be filled with water or sand. It may not be filled with stones, glass, metal, bones, plastics or material scraps. This product is not intended for commercial use. Generally acknowledged accident prevention regulations and enclosed safety instructions must be observed. Only perform work described in these instructions for use, any other use is incorrect. The manufacturer will not assume responsibility for damage resulting from such use.

WARNING

Read this instruction manual carefully before operating this machine. Make sure that you are familiar with the controls and properly operate the machine. Following these instructions can reduce the risk of personal injury.

IF NOT USED PROPERLY THIS MACHINE CAN BE DANGEROUS!

INSPECT YOUR ROLLER

Check all bolts, nuts, and screws for tightness before each use, especially those securing guards and drive mechanisms. Vibration during use may cause these to loosen.

Form a habit of checking to see that all other tools/equipment are removed from the working area before operating. Replace damaged, missing or failed parts before using it. Warning labels carry important information. Replace any missing or damaged warning labels.

DRESS PROPERLY

Do not wear loose clothing, gloves, scarves, neckties, or jewelry (rings, wristwatches), which can be caught in moving parts. Always wear long trousers.

Always wear substantial nonslip, substantial, or heavy-duty safety footwear is highly recommended when working. Never operate barefoot or when wearing sandals. Wear a face or dust mask if the operation is dusty. Always wear safety glasses/goggles and/or face shields.

Everyday eyeglasses have only impact-resistant lenses; they are not safety glasses/goggles. Wear protective hair covering to contain long hair, preventing it from getting caught in machinery.

STORE IDLE EQUIPMENT

When not in use, the roller should be stored in a dry location away from direct sunlight. Keep the machine away from children and others not qualified to use it.

FILLING THE DRUM - WATER

When filling the drum with water, do not connect a hose pipe via a fixed coupling, which could cause a build-up of pressure within the drum. Always empty the roller drum after you have finished using it, in order to prevent it from rusting and also protect from sub-zero temperatures. Antifreeze can be used for further protection.








FILLING THE DRUM – SAND

When filling the drum with sand, it is recommended a large funnel is used to ease the filling method.



ASSEMBLY IS REQUIRED - MINIMUM TWO PERSONS

IMPORTANT:

Never use the roller up and down slopes. Always work across a slope, ensuring the machine towing the roller has no chance of sliding or tipping over.

ROLLER PREPARATION

The roller may be filled with water or sand by removing the fill/drain plug. Filling with the required amount and replacing the plug. If using water in the roller you may want to add anti-freeze during cold weather however, we recommend the roller is drained before winter storage, in order to avoid frost damage even if you have used anti-freeze.

USING YOUR ROLLER

1. DO NOT exceed rated capacity.
2. ALWAYS secure and lock the roller to the ride-on machinery hitch before operating.
3. ONLY use approved vehicles when towing the roller (Lawn/Garden Tractors and ATVs).
4. DO NOT at any time carry passengers on the roller or approved vehicle.

5. ALWAYS adhere to the instructions supplied in the approved vehicle Operator's Manual.
6. Start the vehicle engine with the controls in a neutral position, and put the throttle at the slowest engine speed. Put the transmission in low gear first when entering the work area. Increase the speed as work conditions permit.
7. Vehicle braking and stability may be affected by the attachment of this equipment.
8. NEVER EXCEED 6 MPH when towing the roller.
9. Roll in straight lines, making overlapping passes.
10. DO NOT make sharp turns that may cause the vehicle's tyres to rub against the roller.
11. Avoid extremely sharp turns to prevent damage to the lawn.
12. On sloped lawns, always operate across the slope. Do not exceed the degree of slope indicated in the Operators Manual of your approved vehicle.
13. Always use caution when backing the roller to avoid "jack-knifing". Always back up in a straight line.
14. To increase the compaction of the ground, extra weight may be added to the drum by filling it with water or sand. Never overfill the drum, approximately 75% of the drum's capacity is the maximum weight that should be added.

ATTACHING THE ROLLER TO THE TOW VEHICLE

- Park the tow vehicle and roller on level ground.
- Slide the clevis jaws of the roller below and above the towing hitch of the ride-on machine. Secure by sliding the hitch pin through the locating hole of the clevis jaws and ride-on machine, securing with the large B-pin.

LUBRICATE

Maintenance spray or multi-purpose grease can be applied to the drum spindles prior to long-term storage.

CLEANING

After each use thoroughly clean the roller and scraper bar with a stiff brush.

STORING

Before storing, ensure that the machine is clean and dry. Store in a dry or protected area and coat exposed metal with light oil when not in use. Store out of direct sunlight.

Do not store anything above or near the machine, where anyone might stand on the machine to reach them.

Keep the machine away from children and others not qualified to use it.

CHECK ALL NUTS, BOLTS AND FASTENING

Before each use check all fastenings are tight & secure.

APPEARANCE

If rust appears on metal components, sand lightly and coat with enamel paint.

NEVER EXCEED LOAD CAPACITY

To avoid damaging the roller, never exceed the rated capacity.

TRANSPORT

Secure the device against slipping. When shipping, use the original packaging if possible.
